Yacutinga Wildlife Lodge & Private Reserve

Optional Extension from Iguassu/Iguazu Falls

3 Days / 2 Nights

Located in a private Wildlife Nature Reserve in the heart of the Argentine rainforest, surrounded by the Iguazú National Park. This subtropical region known as the "green corridor" is home to 2000 identified plant species, 400 species of birds, mammals and reptiles, large rivers and a bright green jungle. Enjoy diverse outdoor activities focused on soft adventure and Eco-tourism, (canoeing, biking, bird watching or walking).

The lodge offers you 40 suites, 3 restaurants, a pool and naturalist guides.

Day 1 Iguazu/Yacutinga

Transfer from the Iguazu airport to port La Blanquita, at the shore of the Iguazú river where you will board motorboats for your transfer to port Yacutinga. Upon arrival jeep transfer through the Yacutinga Wild Life Private Reserve to the Lodge. Welcome briefing, dinner and overnight. **(D)**

Day 2 Yacutinga

Full day of activities including hiking, canoeing and wildlife excursions. **(B, L, D)**

Day 3 Yacutinga/Iguassu Falls

Morning at leisure for bird watching or relaxing in the pool area. Farewell lunch and transfer back to Iguassú Falls area. **(B, L)**
