The snow-clad Andes are a dramatic backdrop for Chile's charming capital, Santiago. A short drive into the wine valleys will give you a taste of the world famous Then on to Chile's Patagonia to see the magnificent peaks of the Torres del Paine National Park, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then on to the Chilean Patagonia where the serenity of this enchanting scene is only occasionally disturbed by the cracking of ice loosening from the glacier and breaking into the icebergs and packs.

Day 1 USA/Santiago

Depart via overnight flight to Santiago, Chile.

Day 2 Santiago

Upon arrival at Santiago's international airport, Tourlite hosts will meet you and escort you to your hotel.

Day 3 Santiago

Today's city tour includes la Moneda Presidential Palace, Bernardo O'Higgins and Republic Avenues, the Club Hipico Racetrack, O'Higgins Park and Cristobal Hill for a panoramic view of the city and the majestic Andes. Continue through the residential areas of Vitacura, Los Condes and Providencia, ending the tour at Plaza de Armas. Remainder of the day is at leisure. **(B)**

Day 4 Santiago

Today's full-day tour takes you through some of Chile's world famous vineyards. Stop at several wineries for tastings and enjoy the beautiful scenery. Lunch included. **(B,L)**

Day 5 Santiago/Punta Arenas/ Puerto Natales

Transfer to the Santiago airport for your flight south to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival, Tourlite representatives will meet and transfer you to

the local bus station for your local bus to Puerto Natales. Upon arrival in Puerto Natales, Tourlite representatives will meet you at the bus station and transfer you to your hotel for overnight. **(B)**

Day 6 Puerto Natales/ Torres del Paine

Depart Puerto Natales for a full day excursion to Torres del Paine National Park. En route, visit the Milodon Cave. Declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1978, Torres del Paine National Park, is one of the most beautiful, unspoiled and remote places of the planet. The attractions include its spectacular mountain range, lakes, flora and fauna. **(B,L)**

Day 7 Torres del Paine

Today sail to the Grey Glacier. A part of the Southern Ice Field you will sail for 35 minutes among many icebergs to the center of front wall. Here you will see the size and infinity of crevasses and snowdrifts that get lost in the distance. This afternoon is at leisure for optional activities such as hiking or horseback riding. **(B)**

Day 8 Torres del Paine/ Puerto Natales/Punta Arenas

This morning you will be transferred to the Puerto Natales bus station for your local bus to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival in Punta Arenas you will be transferred to your hotel. **(B)**

Day 9 Punta Arenas/Santiago/USA

This morning's city tour of Punta Arenas will include a panoramic view of the city and the Strait of Magellan, a visit to the Salesian Museum, housing a magnificent collection of the regional flora and fauna, exclusive relics of handicraft and folklore of the native Indian tribes. Later, transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago and connection to the USA and home. **(B)**
