LIMA

3 days/2 nights from \$185

Lima, was founded by Francisco Pizarro and was considered the jewel of the Spanish Empire and once the capital and the "City of Kings." Lima is a mosaic of colonial and modern architecture. A thriving metropolis of museums, galleries, shopping centers and nightlife.

Day 1: Arrival, meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel. This afternoon visit colonial Lima. At the cathedral you can see the remains of the conqueror Pizarro. Later visit beautiful Miraflores and San Isidoro residential areas.

Day 2: This morning you will visit the Gold Museum displaying a dazzling array of gold, silver and copper works from Peru's many civilizations. (B)

Day 3: Transfer to the airport. (B)

AMAZON/PUERTO MALDONADO

3 days/2 nights from \$265

Day 1: Puerto Maldonado - Upon arrival in Puerto Maldonado transfer to the Madre de Dios river pier. Board your motor boat for the 45 minute trip to the Reserva Amazonica Jungle Lodge. The lodge is built entirely by the native Indian tribes. After lunch at the lodge, begin your explorations of the Amazon. Dinner and overnight at the Amazon Lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 2: Amazon - Guided Amazonian explorations. Your local guide will escort you for a full day of discovery and adventure including boat rides on the river and to the Rolin Island (Monkey Island), where six different species of monkeys can be seen. Dinner and overnight at the Amazon Jungle Lodge. (B,L,D)

Day 3: Puerto Maldonado - This morning, transfer to the airport. (B)

CUZCO/MACHU PICCHU (OVERNIGHT MACHU PICCHU)

4 days/3 nights from \$590

The "Lost City of the Incas", this is truly one of the wonders of the world. Believed to have been built in the mid-15th century, it was not discovered until 1911 by American explorer Hiram Bingham. Surrounded by a lush cloud forest, the imposing citadel perches on atop a mountain.

Day 1: Cuzco. Arrival, meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel. Take some time to acclimate yourself to the 11,000 foot altitude. This afternoon tour Cuzco and the imposing ruins. (B,L)

Day 2: Cuzco/Machu Picchu. Early morning departure by train for the full day excursion to Machu Picchu. Overnight at Machu Picchu. (B,L)

Day 3: Machu Picchu/Cuzco. Second entrance to the magnificent citadel for continued sightseeing and wondering on your own. Afternoon return to Cuzco. (B)

Day 4: This morning transfer to the airport. (B)

Day 3: After an early lunch you will be transferred to Iquitos Airport. (B,L)

CUZCO/MACHU PICCHU

3 days/2 nights from \$470

The city of Cuzco was at one time the capital of the formidable Inca empire and now the center of one of the most important archaeological regions in the world. A highlight of your visit is the excursion to Machu Picchu the mysterious "Lost City of the Incas."

Day 1: Cuzco. Arrival, meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel. Take some time to acclimate yourself to the 11,000 foot altitude. This afternoon tour the city ruins of Sacsay-Huaman, the stone carving of Kenko and Tambo Machay, once the baths of Incan royalty.

Day 2: Early morning departure for a full-day excursion to Machu Picchu, "The Lost City of the Incas" truly one of the wonders of the world. Machu Picchu was only discovered in 1911. This self-contained city consists of over 200 building and is practically inaccessible and unnoticeable from the valley below. (B L)

Day 3: This morning transfer to the airport. (B)

PUNO/LAKE TITICACA

3 days/2 nights from \$345

Puno was once one of the continent's richest cities. It is the folkloric center of Peru and source of much Incan mythology. Lake Titicaca the Inca's "Divine Lake" at 12,580 feet, is the highest navigable waterway in the world.

Day 1: Cuzco/Juliaca/Puno - Morning departure from Cuzco by train. Travel through the high Andes past picturesque villages and spectacular views to Juliaca. Here you will transfer to a motor coach for the remaining journey to the Peruvian Border Town of Puno, on the shores of Lake Titicaca. (L)

Day 2: Puno - This morning, tour the floating reed islands of the Uros Indians, a lake tribe whose unique lifestyle has remained unchanged for thousands of years. Box lunch is provided. Continue by boat visiting the island of Taquile, and the Quecha speaking Indians, boasting the world's finest hand-weaving technique. Return to Puno. (B,L)

Day 3: Lima - Transfer to the airport in Juliaca. (B)

YUCAY - SACRED VALLEY

A stay in Urubamba, the Sacred Valley, is the perfect way to relax in the heart of the country. Yucay is the adventure tourism center of the Sacred Valley where you can enjoy river rafting, rock climbing, mountain biking, horse rides and trekking. A highlight is the visit to the Pisac Market and the ruins and Ollantaytambo.

Day 1: Cuzco/Yucay. Full day tour visiting the famous Pisac Market and Ollantaytambo, the oldest continuously-occupied settlement in the Americas. Archaeologists believe construction here was cut short by the arrival of the Spaniards. Overnight in Yucay. (B,L)

Day 2: Yucay/Cuzco airport. Early morning transfer to the Cuzco airport.
