Torres del Paine National Park

Day 1 USA/Santiago

Depart via overnight flight to Santiago, Chile.

Day 2 Santiago

Upon arrival at Santiago's international airport, Tourlite hosts will meet you and escort you to your hotel.

Day 3 Santiago

Santiago, founded in 1541, is a mixture between the old and modern times. On today's city tour you drive past many famous monuments and visit the Santa Lucia Hill to enjoy a panoramic view of the city, the Main Square, the Cathedral, the Government Palace and Horse Club. **(B)**

Day 4 Santiago

Today's full-day tour takes you through some of Chile's world famous vineyards. Stop at several wineries for tastings and enjoy the beautiful scenery. Lunch included. **(B,L)**

Day 5 Santiago/Punta Arenas/ Puerto Natales

Transfer to the Santiago airport for your flight south to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival, Tourlite representatives will meet and you will begin your excursion northward on the Brunswick Peninsula along the Strait of Magellan. Continue to Otway Sound, unfolding a beauti-

ful landscape bays and fjords toward the Pecket mine, an important open-pit coal mineral deposit. Finally, the tour arrives at the nest site of the Magellan Penguins. Continue to Puerto Natales for overnight with a stop of lunch en route. **(B, L)**

Day 6 Puerto Natales/ Torres del Paine

Depart Puerto Natales for a full day excursion to Torres del Paine National Park. En route, visit the Milodon Cave. Declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1978, Torres del Paine National Park, is one of the most beautiful, unspoiled and remote places of the planet. The attractions include the Grande Fall, Norderkjöld lake, Lake Pehoe, view of the Cuernos del Paine, Salto Chico, Torres del Paine, Grey Glacier and Lake Grey where you will enjoy a picnic lunch. **(B,L)**

Day 7 Torres del Paine

Morning half day excursion to the Blue Lagoon where you have the opportunity to observe flora and the fauna and the towers of the Torres del Paine National Park. This afternoon is at leisure for optional activities such as hiking or horseback riding. **(B)**

Day 8 Torres del Paine/ Puerto Natales/Punta Arenas

This morning you will be transferred to the Puerto Natales bus station for your local bus to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival in Punta Arenas you will be transferred to your hotel. **(B)**

Day 9 Punta Arenas/Santiago/USA

This morning's city tour of Punta Arenas will include a panoramic view of the city and the Strait of Magellan, a visit to the Salesian Museum, housing a magnificent collection of the regional flora and fauna, exclusive relics of handicraft and folklore of the native Indian tribes. Later, transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago and connection to the USA and home. **(B)**
