Legend has it that Manco Capac and Mama Ocllo, sent by the Sun God to civilize mankind, emerged from the sacred waters of Lake Titicaca to found the Inca Empire. Follow Tourlite's "Incan Passage" from Lima to La Paz in search of the legacies and mysteries of this remarkable, ancient civilization. En route, visit Cuzco, capital city of the Inca Empire and archaeological center of South America; legendary Machu Picchu the lost city of the Incas; and the colorful market town of Pisac and the fortress of Ollantaytambo in the Sacred Valley. Discover the floating reed islands of the Uros people and cross the expanse of Lake Titicaca on the way to La Paz, capital of Bolivia and the world's highest city.

Day 1 USA/Lima

Depart the USA via overnight flight en route to Lima, Peru.

Day 2 Lima

Morning arrival. Tourlite representatives will meet and transfer you to your hotel. This afternoon, visit colonial Lima, the San Francisco Monastery and drive through beautiful Miraflores and San Isidro.

Day 6 Cuzco/Puno

This morning, depart from Cuzco by bus. Travel through the Andes with stops at the colonial church of Andahuaylillas, Raqchi the pre-Inca Temple of Wiracocha and the archeological site at Pukara. Upon arrival at the Peruvian border town of Puno, on the shores of Lake Titicaca, you will be transferred to your hotel. **(B, L)**

Day 7 Puno

Once one of the continent's richest cities, Puno is the folkloric center of Peru and source of much of Incan mythology. This morning, tour the floating reed islands of the Uros Indians, a lake tribe whose unique lifestyle has remained unchanged for thousands of years. This afternoon, visit the Sillustani Chulpas, circular burial towers built almost 2,000 years ago. **(B)**

Day 8 Catamaran Cruise across Lake Titicaca

Early transfer to Copacabana Sanctuary, board the Catamaran Cruise ship and sail to Sun Island, the legendary birthplace of the Inca Empire. Visit the Inca Garden, Inti Wata Cultural Complex, Titicaca

reed shipbuilders display centers, Pachamama agricultural Inca Terraces, the Intica lounge and at the Manco Capac look out, the largest variety of Andean Cameloids. At Sun Island sail aboard huge Titicaca traditional vessel visiting the Pilkokaina Inca Palace. Also visit the Challapampa Village. Dinner and overnight on board the catamaran. **(B,L,D)**

Day 9 Cruise/La Paz

Continue your Catamaran cruise to Bolivia, where on arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in La Paz, the world's highest capital city. **(B)**

Day 10 La Paz

The city lies in a natural basin protected from the harsh Andean wind. This afternoon, having acclimated yourself to the altitude, you'll see the highlights of the city and visit the Valley of the Moon, a unique landscape created by the natural forces of the wind and weather. **(B)**

Day 11 La Paz/USA

Today, you'll be transferred to the airport for you flight to the USA and home. **(B)**
